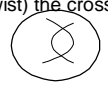


IMPORTANT
Whenever one line crosses another line, wrap (or twist) the crossing line



Begin here with a 12 yrd rope
Tie a Lark's head Knot. This creates 2 ropes.

Follow the pattern, tying a Lark's head at each number or letter

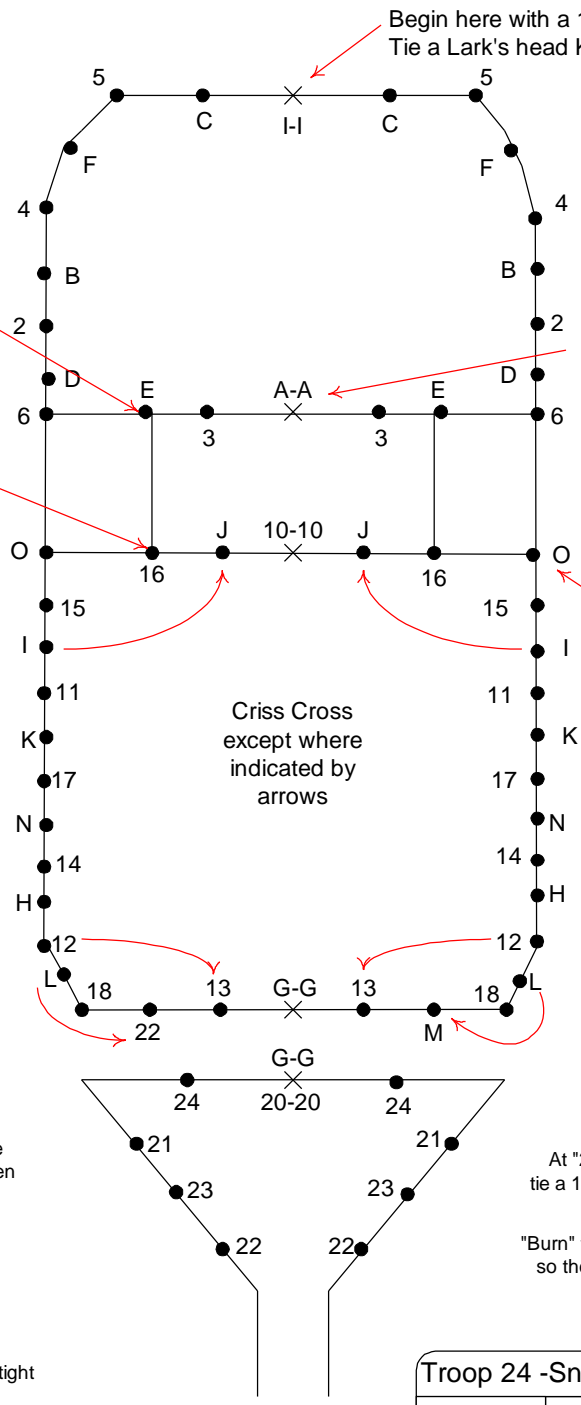
With a lark's head, tie an 8' rope here.

Tie another 12 1/2 ft. rope here
Follow pattern, tying a single Lark's head at each letter.

Loop around here
Then "wrap" up to beginning spot.

Tie a 14 ft. rope. Start with a Lark's head, then tie on the other side. Then, with the rope still doubled, "wrap" the line and resecure it at the beginning spot. Use any additional rope to wrap again.

With a Lark's head, tie a 24 ft. rope at 10-10 and a 24 ft. rope at G-G.



Criss Cross
except where
indicated by
arrows

#21,23,22 Should be spaced evenly between the bar and "tail"

At "20-20" tie a 10 ft rope

"Burn" the rope ends so they don't fray

IMPORTANT
Keep the webbing as tight as possible!
